#### **CONFERENCE**

Delegates are expected to arrive at the conference venue, Mabanga Farmers' Training Centre on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2008 by 15.00 hrs for registration. Mabanga F.T.C is situated along the Eldoret-Bungoma highway, 5 Kilometers before Bungoma Town.

International delegates should book their flights to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, Nairobi, from where they may proceed to Kisumu Airport by internal flights at an extra Kshs. 10,500/=. Alternatively they may travel by road from Nairobi to Bungoma. One way bus ticket costs Kshs. 1,000/=. Organizers will arrange to meet delegates in Nairobi or Kisumu as necessary. Delegates arriving from Nairobi and Eldoret by road should alight at Mabanga. The Mabanga bus stop is right at the gate of the F.T.C. Those arriving from Uganda should alight at Kanduyi. Mabanga is 3 Kilometres ahead on the Malaba–Eldoret road. There are numerous vehicles which will take passengers to Mabanga for Kshs. 50/= only.
